


MEET OUR SUMMER INTERN!

Camp Family – Praise The Lord! We have started off 2016 with a running start! Contributions are above and overall expenses below our projected budget. But practically speaking, this may be a bit misleading. We have had some lump sum annual contributions made this year already; this is common at the end of the year but not normally at the beginning. Also, at this time of year expenses have not “caught up” with us yet. For example, we have budgeted an annual amount of \$6,000 for a Duke Intern, that amount is annualized in the budget at \$500 per month. So at this point, we are \$1,500 below budget for an expense we will not actually incur until summer. Also, we are in the process of making unexpected repairs to the roof of the old building. Apportionments are another factor. So please keep this in mind and prayer when considering your financial commitment to the




