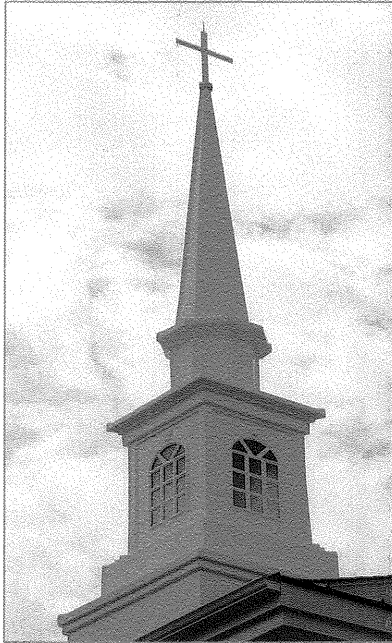

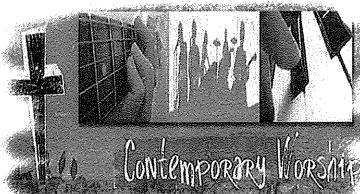

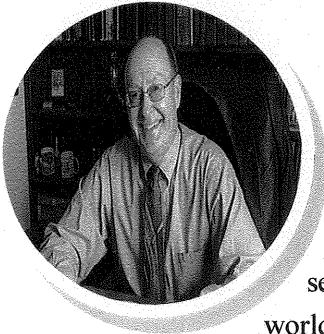

FEBRUARY 2016

"For God so loved the world" ..... So begins one of the most famous two verses in the Bible. Sometimes we forget the second part of that scripture ... "for God sent His son into the world **NOT TO CONDEMN** THE WORLD but that **THE WORLD**

**MIGHT BE SAVED THROUGH HIM**". As we enter a new month we need to remember those words. We need to remember that love and salvation, in Christian theology, goes hand in hand. Why; because recently Camp has gone through a difficult period of time with the death of some very wonderful people. As I type this on a Saturday morning I am preparing for Michael Russ's funeral service on Sunday. His will be the fourth celebration of life we have had in a month. In the last ten months we have remembered and celebrated the life of eleven wonderful people. Combined with that all the wonderful people in our church dealing with loved ones diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease and other serious health issues, you may wonder why I began this article with, "for God so love the world"! I did so to remind us that God loves us not just in the wonderful moments of life but in the more difficult moments of life as well. We all know that February is called the month of love. It even has a special day of love called Valentine's Day in it. As we enter this month we need to remember not just that fact but that the verse found in **John 3:16 & 17 are considered God's valentine to us**. Remember that God loves each one of us and those are not just "preacher words", they are **THE WORDS OF GOD FOR THE PEOPLE OF GOD!** We need to remember that Jesus saves, and what that means for each of us every day of our life, not just on a Sunday morning. Note: The "good news" is that the year's financial results met the bank required Debt Service Ratio of 1.0. The "bad news" is that in order to accomplish this we fell short, by \$8,665, in meeting our 2016 Apportionment goal. This is the first time since the 1960's that Camp has not paid 100% of the Apportionment amount. Current Church Mortgage Debt as of 12/31/2016 = \$1,277,944.47

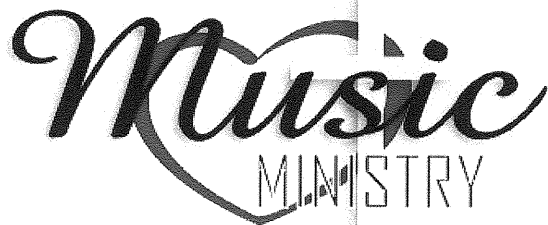

## WHAT A FRIEND WE HAVE IN JESUS—Written by Joseph M. Scriven (1819-1886)

Not far from Port Hope, Ontario stands a monument with this inscription: "Four miles north, in Pengally's Cemetery, lies the philanthropist and author of this great masterpiece, written at Port Hope, 1857." Above the inscription are the words of the beloved hymn WHAT A FRIEND WE HAVE IN JESUS. Joseph Scriven, its author, was a man who had experienced the friendship of Jesus through a life filled with personal tragedy.

When Scriven was a young man in Ireland, his fiancée accidentally drowned the evening before their wedding. Soon after this, Scriven set sail for Canada. He seemed destined to live his life alone, with Jesus as his only close friend. Scriven never intended to publish this hymn. He wrote the words to accompany a letter to his mother, who was ill in far-off Ireland. He had no material resources to send her; only a reminder that the most perfect of friends, Jesus Himself, was nearby.

## MUSIC MEMORIALS

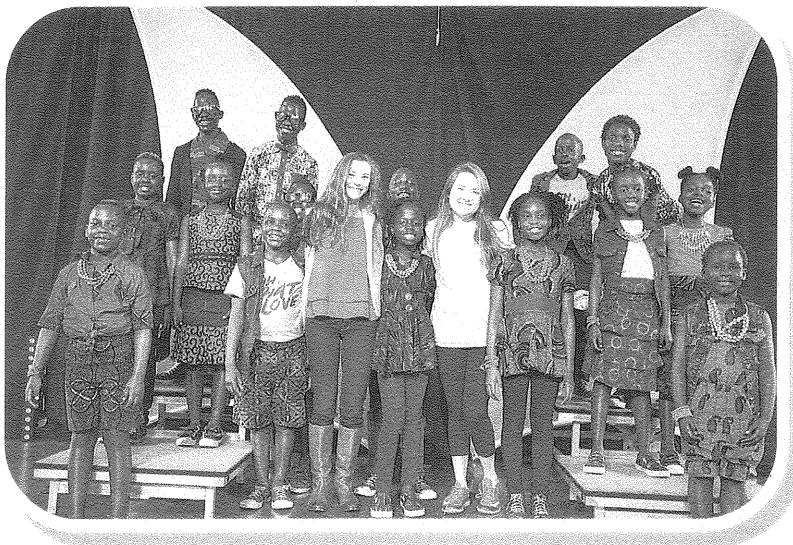
