

Cadence of a Deep Call: a Call to Bless

One of my spiritual practices is to bless my family, friends, and church families on their birthdays. When I call them I remind them of the blessedness in their lives; how much they have meant to me, my family, and many of us, how much they have been blessings to many people around them. Many times I even sing to a happy birthday song to them! When I bless them I hear their deep appreciation for my blessing and I also feel how much I am needed to them. Blessing brings joy, thanksgiving, and affirmation of self-worth.

Our society is full of cursing. There are many tragedies in our lives: accidents, floods, earthquakes, wildfires, deaths, diseases, divorces, etc. It is so easy for us to think of ourselves as victims of these cursing. The tragedies in our lives may lead us to think that we are not worth living. When the bad things happen to us we naturally think of ourselves under cursing.


The saints in the Old and New Testament blessed people around them. Jacob blessed his twelve children at his deathbed. He blessed the two grandchildren of Joseph. Aaron was called to bless his people: "The Lord bless you and keep you. The Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you. The Lord lift up his countenance and give you peace." (Numbers 6: 24-26). Saint Paul always started every letter he wrote to his congregation with his blessing: "The grace and peace of our Lord, Jesus Christ be with you."

Jesus came to bless us, not to curse us. On the night even when he was betrayed by his close friend he said to others, "I have said these things to you, so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." (John 15:11). He came to give us life, not death. He came to make us whole. He came to forgive our sins and set us free from shame, guilt, and regrets. He came to give us eternal life. He came to bless us!

Our response to his blessings is to pass on his blessing to others. Our kind words, our deep appreciation, our random act of kindness, our verbal and non-verbal blessings are to pass on to others who need our blessings each and every day. People need blessings from us. They cry for mercy and compassion. They cry for genuine and authentic blessings from us.





MISSION & OUTREACH



FOOD PANTRY/SBIC- The CROP Walk is Sunday, November 5th. This year, SBIC is partnering with Greater Shallotte Ministerial Association to have “CROP Walk/Praise in the Park” event, together at Mulberry Park. This will be info sharing by participating churches, about each church’s activities, programs, upcoming events, etc. The churches are invited to set up a table or tent at Mulberry Park for this. The CROP Walk will start in Mulberry Park at 2:15, cross over Main Street, proceed up Village Ave to Calvary Baptist Church and return back to the park, about 3 miles. Following the Walk, Praise and Worship events will commence and should end around 5:00 pm. Outreach will have a CROP Walk sign-up sheets and collection envelopes in our narthex the month of October.

HOMELESS/BUILDING HOPE MINISTRY- The Outreach Committee donated \$200 to Building Hope Ministries for their Angel Tree (prisoners’ kids) Christmas Program. This will be used to buy the children gift cards for Christmas. .

PRISON MINISTRY- There remains a need for more women Christian leaders for Bible study at the Brunswick County Detention Center. There is only 2-3 total, and when one or more of them is out this leaves a void in the program, sometimes with no study at all for Sunday, for the women. Kristen Hooks is the contact person for this.

MILITARY/POLICE FORCE- 1) Our committee wants to recognize military family and friends of our congregation and will be collecting addresses to mail cards to them. There will be information in our bulletins for the next couple of weeks. Jeanne Frederick is the contact person for this. 2) Our “Adopt-A-Cop” program is going well with 15 BC Sheriff employees assigned to our church. We will be sending them cards regularly with occasional gift card, showing our support of them. Barbara Votik is the contact person for this.

MONTHLY HOSPICE MEALS- If anyone, or a group, would like to sign up for the next meal, December 15th, you can contact Sharon Sloane at sharonsloane@me.com. The meal should be planned for approximately 12 people, who are family members of Hospice patients. Hospice requests we sign in at the front desk volunteer book. Also to place food in smaller containers, for storage purposes, with a label with date and Camp UMC on it.

RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE- Our next blood drive will be November 9th, 2:30 to 7:00 pm in our Fellowship Hall. Contact Barbara Varnam at bgvarnam@atmc.net to sign up.

POWER WALKING MINISTRIES- So far this school year, PWM has given 73 pairs of athletic shoes to children in BC schools. Around November 1st, parents of approximately 300 children will be contacted for sizes and preferences, of shoes, for their kids, for Christmas. Our committee has agreed to take 25, for our congregation to fill. We hope to have a PWM tree alongside our BFA “Tree of Hope” for people to take a tag and adopt.
