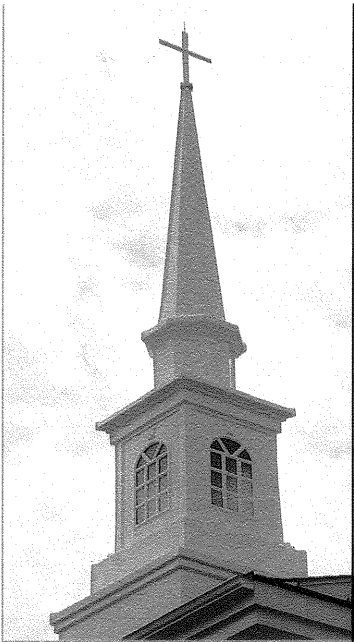

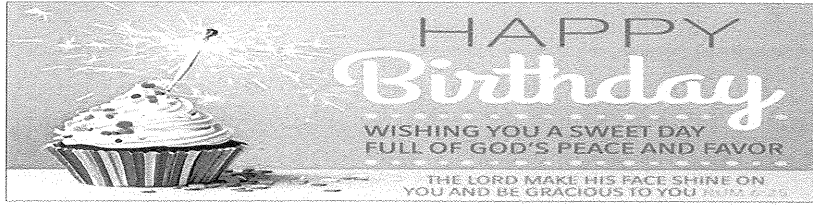

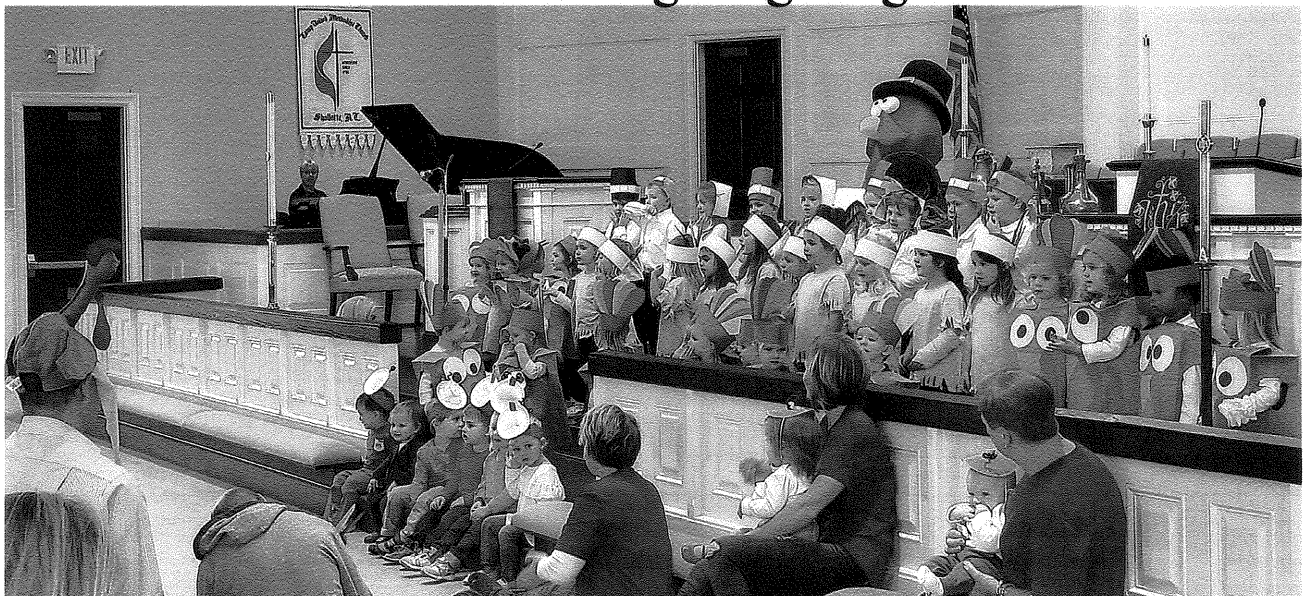

FOOD PANTRY/SBIC- 1) There will be no Food Pantry November 18 because of UMW bake fair. 2) Meals On Wheels/ SBIC supply Thanksgiving dinners to the needy, and our church always helps by baking turkeys for them. This year they request 7 baked turkeys, to be prepared the Wednesday before Thanksgiving, from our congregation. Thank you to those who walked and donated money and also those who donated their time to come out and help us.

PRISON MINISTRY- There remains a need for more women Christian leaders for Bible study at the Brunswick County Detention Center. There is only 2-3 total, and when one or more of them is out this leaves a void in the program, sometimes with no study at all for Sunday, for the women. Kristen Hooks is the contact person for this.

MILITARY/POLICE FORCE- 1) Our committee wants to recognize military family and friends of our congregation and will be collecting addresses to mail cards to them. So far packages and cards have been sent to 2 of our military family members. 2) Our "Adopt-A-Cop" program is going well with 15 BC Sheriff employees assigned to our church. We will be sending them cards regularly with occasional gift card, showing our support of them. Barbara Votik is the contact person for this.

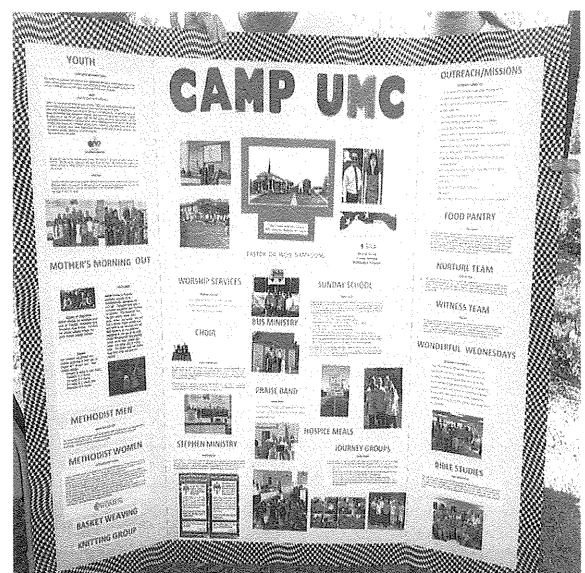
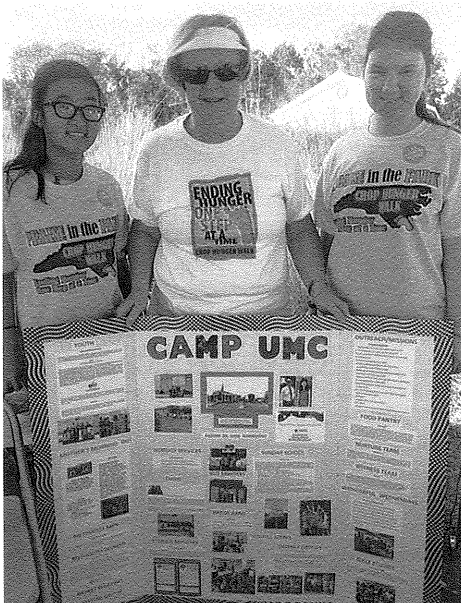

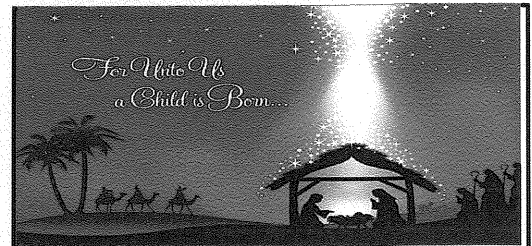
